## RESOLUTION OF THE LOW MOUNTAIN CHAPTER

**LMC-2025-043: THE CONSITUENTS OF LOW MOUNTAIN CHAPTER HEREBY SUPPORT AND APPROVE NAVAJO TRANSITIONAL ENGERY COMPANY'S (NTEC) EFFORS TO CREATE THE NAVENERGERGY HUB WHICH WILL EMPLOY CLEAN COAL POWER GENERATION VIA CARBON CAPTURE, SOLAR AND GAS PLANTS AND NEW TRANSMISSION TO EXTEND THE LIFE OF NAVAJO MINE AND THE FOUR CORNERS POWER PLANT IN SAN JUAN COUNTY ON THE NAVAJO NATION.**

### WHEREAS:

1. Pursuant to 26 NNC, Section 1 (B), the Navajo Nation Council delegated the authority to Low Mountain Chapter to review and process all local matters affecting the community and its constituents, assuring that quality services are provided and Section 101 (A)(B), Low Mountain Chapter shall operate under the Five Management System (FMS), consistent with applicable Navajo Nation Laws; **AND,**
2. Pursuant to 26NNC, Section 103(A), Low Mountain Chapter membership are authorized to oversee the authority delegated to the chapter and Section 1004(A), Low Mountain Chapter shall enact by resolutions plans of operations, for all executive functions and administrative policies of the chapter; **AND,**
3. Navajo Transitional Energy Company (NTEC) was created by the Navajo Nation to develop and manage the Nation's conventional, alternative, and renewable energy resources; **AND,**
4. NTEC's responsible development of the NavEnergy Hub using Clean Coal Power Generation via Carbon Capture, Solar and Gas generation, and new Transmission lines will protect the resources of the Navajo People and the Navajo Nation while also supporting the Nation's effort to lead in a clean energy future; **AND,**
5. NTEC's NavEnergy Hub will maintain the predominantly Navajo jobs at Navajo Mine and the Four Corner Power Plant; as well as continue to support Navajo Vendors/Contractors; **AND,**
6. NTEC's NavEnergy Hub will allow NTEC to continue the Community based programs supporting the Navajo People, i.e. Scholarships, Community Benefit Fund Grants, Community Heating Resource Program and other Education initiatives; **AND,**
7. Chapter has reviewed the information regarding the NavEnergy Hub and recognizes the significance of its impact to both the Navajo Nation General Fund, the Navajo Economy and the Navajo People.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:**




